A BILL

To amend the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act to recognize digital skills and digital literacy as critical adult education and literacy objectives, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Investing in Digital
5 Skills Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.**

7 Section 3 of the Workforce Innovation and Oppor-
8 tunity Act (29 U.S.C. 3102) is amended—

1 (1) by redesignating paragraphs (15) through
2 (71) as paragraphs (16) through (72), respectively;
3 and

4 (2) by inserting after paragraph (14) the fol-
5 lowing:

6 “(15) **DIGITAL LITERACY SKILLS.**—The term
7 ‘digital literacy skills’ has the meaning given the
8 term in section 202 of the Museum and Library
9 Services Act (20 U.S.C. 9101).”.

10 **SEC. 3. ADULT DIGITAL LITERACY SKILLS.**

11 (a) **PURPOSE.**—Section 202 of the Workforce Innova-
12 tion and Opportunity Act (29 U.S.C. 3271) is amended—

13 (1) by amending paragraph (1) to read as fol-
14 lows:

15 “(1) assist adults to become literate and obtain
16 the knowledge and skills (including digital literacy
17 skills and information literacy) necessary for employ-
18 ment, economic self-sufficiency, and full participa-
19 tion in all aspects of adult life;” and

20 (2) in paragraph (4)(A)—

21 (A) in clause (i), by striking “and” at the
22 end; and

23 (B) by inserting after clause (ii) the fol-
24 lowing:

1 “(iii) digital literacy skills and infor-
2 mation literacy; and”.

3 (b) DEFINITIONS.—Section 203 of the Workforce In-
4 novation and Opportunity Act (29 U.S.C. 3272) is amend-
5 ed—

6 (1) by redesignating paragraphs (10) through
7 (17) as paragraphs (11) through (18), respectively;
8 (2) in paragraph (1)—

9 (A) in subparagraph (B), by striking
10 “and” at the end;

11 (B) by redesignating subparagraph (C) as
12 subparagraph (D); and

13 (C) by inserting after subparagraph (B)
14 the following:

15 “(C) develop and use digital technology
16 skills; and”;

17 (3) in paragraph (2), by inserting “, digital
18 skills activities offered in conjunction with other
19 adult education and literacy activities” after “family
20 literacy activities”;

21 (4) in paragraph (9), by adding at the end the
22 following:

23 “(E) Digital literacy and information lit-
24 eracy activities to enable parents or family
25 members to develop and use digital literacy

1 skills and information literacy to support their
2 children’s learning.”; and

3 (5) by inserting after paragraph (9) the fol-
4 lowing:

5 “(10) INFORMATION LITERACY.—The term ‘in-
6 formation literacy’ means the set of skills needed to
7 find, retrieve, understand, evaluate, analyze, and ef-
8 fectively use information (which encompasses spoken
9 and broadcast words and videos, printed materials,
10 and digital content, data, and images).”.

11 (6) in paragraph (14), as redesignated by para-
12 graph (1), by striking “and solve problems,” and all
13 that follows through the period at the end and in-
14 serting “solve problems, and use digital technology
15 at levels of proficiency necessary to function effec-
16 tively as an employee, a parent or a family member,
17 and a member of society.”.

18 **SEC. 4. PROHIBITION ON FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR PRO-**
19 **GRAMS THAT INVOLVE POLITICAL ACTIVI-**
20 **TIES.**

21 Section 194(6) of the Workforce Innovation and Op-
22 portunity Act (29 U.S.C. 3254(6)) is amended by striking
23 “title” and inserting “Act”.
