Newport News	The project is intended to allow the City to purchase, from willing sellers, 12 parcels of land that are adjacent to the main gate of Joint Base Langley Eustis, Fort Eustis. The parcels acquired will create a buffer around the installation to prevent encroachment and incompatible development.	Newport News City VA	\$750
US Navy	Funding would accelerate planning and design for the fuel storage tanks at Craney Island fuel depot, a strategic fuel site for DLA Energy supporting the Navy and U.S. Transportation Command.	Portsmouth VA	\$3,990

US Army Reserve	Funds planning and design money for future construction of a 200-member Army Reserve Center (ARC) Training Building and an Unheated Storage Building on land to be acquired from the Defense Logistics Agency in Richmond, Virginia.	Richmond VA	\$3,300
