 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Military Spouse Hiring
- 5 Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. ELIGIBILITY OF SPOUSES OF MILITARY PERSONNEL
- 7 FOR THE WORK OPPORTUNITY CREDIT.
- 8 (a) In General.—Paragraph (1) of section 51(d) of
- 9 the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by striking

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- 1 "or" at the end of subparagraph (I), by striking the period
- 2 at the end of subparagraph (J) and inserting ", or", and
- 3 by adding at the end the following new subparagraph:
- 4 "(K) a qualified military spouse.".
- 5 (b) QUALIFIED MILITARY SPOUSE.—Subsection (d)
- 6 of section 51 of such Code is amended by adding at the
- 7 end the following new paragraph:
- 8 "(16) QUALIFIED MILITARY SPOUSE.—The
- 9 term 'qualified military spouse' means any individual
- who is certified by the designated local agency as
- being (as of the hiring date) a spouse of a member
- of the Armed Forces of the United States.".
- (c) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 14 this section shall apply to amounts paid or incurred after
- 15 the date of the enactment of this Act to individuals who
- 16 begin work for the employer after such date.
